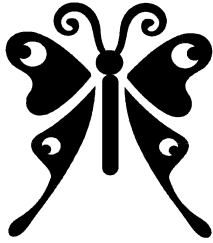

2007...Who could have expected the growth that the Missouri East Chrysalis community has already experienced. Through the Girls and Boys Chrysalis Journeys in January and the Girls and Boys Chrysalis Flights in February, 57 new Butterflies were added to the Chrysalis community. 57 new young women and men brought further along in their journey of faith. 57 new young women and men brought closer to Christ. 57 new young women and men received training in the principles of Christian leadership. 57 new young women and men challenged to become the hands and feet of Christ as they were brought forth in the Priesthood of all Believers.

Over the last three years, the Missouri East Chrysalis Community has hosted the Chrysalis Journeys for college age participants during the month of January. In the hopes of being able to make the weekend available to more college age participants the next Chrysalis Journeys will be held at First United Methodist Church in Jefferson City, November 2-4, 2007 (Boys Journey #11) and November 9-11 (Girls Journey #12). Participation Rates

As most of you already know, the Board of Directors reluctantly had to increase the rates for participants. There have been several factors behind this rate increase including increased costs for the use of the weekend facilities as well as an increase in the Upper Room fees for Caterpillar participants. The increases do not currently affect the Caterpillars (\$100), but do affect the team participants with Youth (\$115) and adults (\$125). If you are called to serve on a team,

please do not let the fee deter you from serving Christ.

The Upper Room has requested and advised all Chrysalis communities to change their before and after meal grace songs, both words and music. The new words can be found on page 3 of this newsletter.

Team Formation

Directions from Interstate 270:

Take (Gravois Road) Hwy 30 West (approx 23 miles) to Revive Us Again at 8350 Hwy 30 Dittmer, MO 63023. From 270, Hwy 141 is (approx 3 miles). Hwy W crosses Hwy 30 (approx 10 miles before) Revive Us Again. Hwy 30 goes from a 4 lane divided road to 2 lane (approx 4 miles) before Revive Us Again (on the left or south side of the road). St. Clair, MO is (approx 17 miles) West of Revive Us Again on Hwy 30 at Interstate 44.

Directions from Interstate 40:

Take Hwy 141 South through Valley Park, MO to the intersection of Hwy 141 & Hwy 30 (Fenton, MO). Take Hwy 30 West (approx 20 miles) to Revive Us Again.

Directions from Eureka, MO:

(Interstate 44 & Hwy 109). Take Hwy 109 South past I-44 where it becomes Hwy W. Follow Hwy W (approx 6 miles) to Hwy 30. Take Hwy 30 West (approx 10 miles) to Revive Us Again.
